

Please note: Books smelling of mildew, damaged books, encyclopedias, textbooks or instruction manuals are unacceptable and will be refused.


Lego/Minecraft Club Wednesday, December 6 at 3:45 PM

10-Minute Play Writing Workshop Saturday, December 9 at 1 PM


Study the secrets and structures of 10-minute plays in a workshop with Marnie Dresser, a widely published writer and Professor of English




Movie Night—Despicable Me 3 Friday, December 15 at 4 PM
