Spring Green is one of the most unique and interesting communities in the roster of Sauk County places. One of the few villages that did not grow up around a mill site, the birth of Spring Green is attributed to the railroad and Spring Green has the honor of being the site of the first railroad connection within the boundaries of Sauk County. The early history of Spring Green will be the subject of two presentation by Sauk County Historical Society Executive Director Paul Wolter. Topics explored will range from the naming of the community to the villages early years as a temperance community and much more.

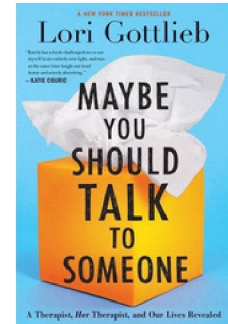
Book Discussion

Tech Drop-in

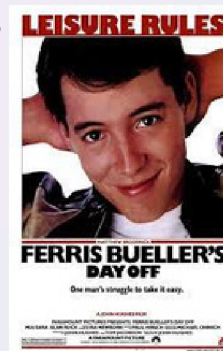
Tues., Sept. 12 at 4p

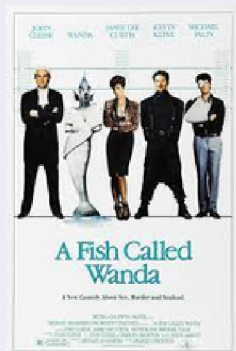
Movies, Munchies, and More

Every Tuesday at 1p, come to the Library for a cup of coffee, a sweet treat, and either a movie or a presentation. Doors open at 12:30p.

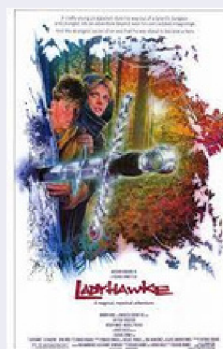
