Teen voices needed! Come tell us what you'd like the Library to offer. This will be a monthly opportunity to share ideas on Library programming and materials that you see!

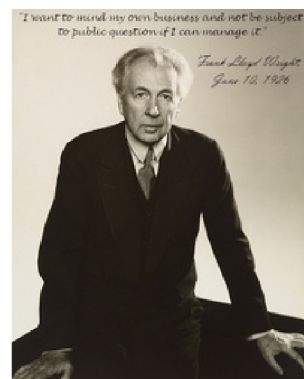


Adults
