Every Tuesday at 1p, come to the Library for a cup of coffee, a sweet treat, and either a movie or a presentation.

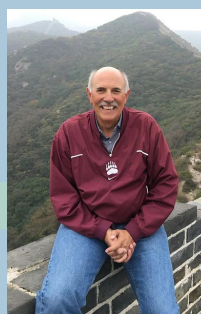
