

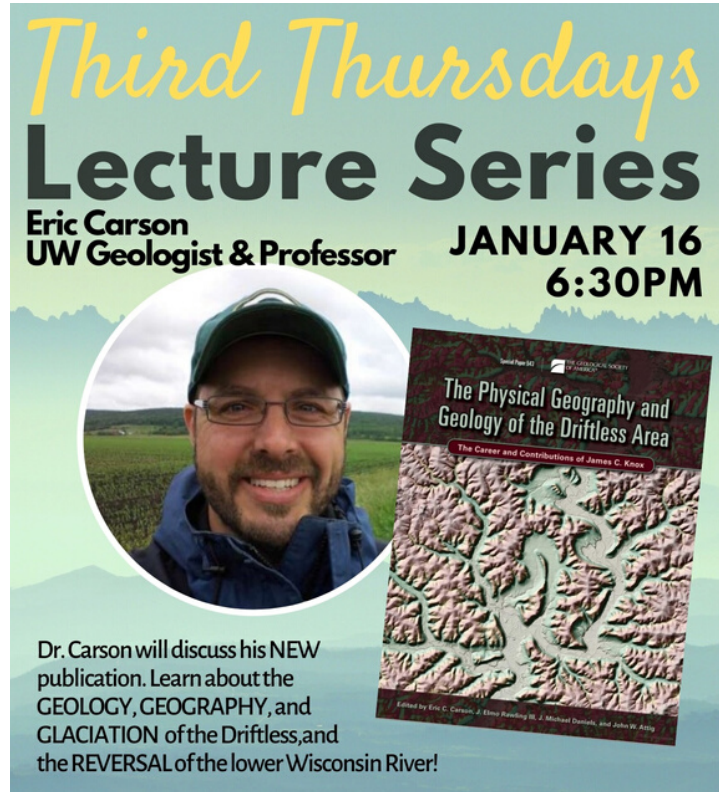


# This Month AT THE LIBRARY

## USED BOOK DONATION

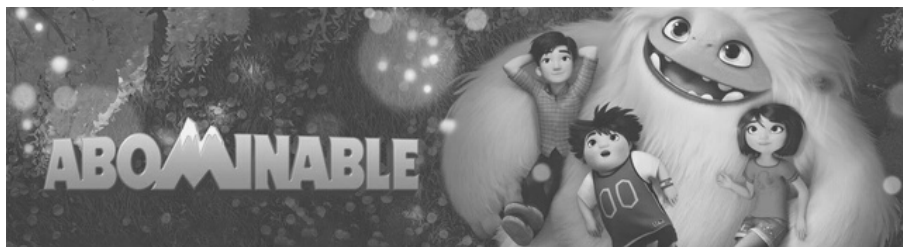
**SATURDAY JANUARY 4, 10AM**

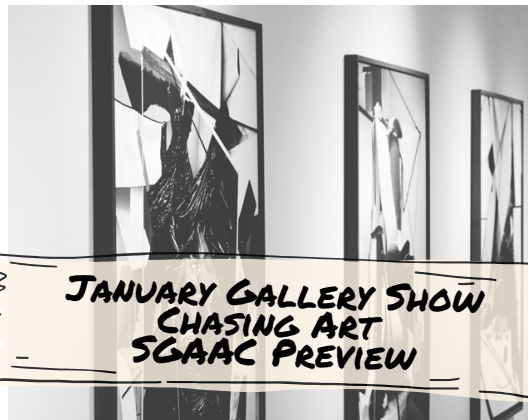


## FUTURE OF ARTS & COMMUNITY
