Join Miss Maddie for a fun and interactive Storytime. You can expect songs, stories, rhymes, puppets, crafts, and more.



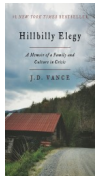
Lego/Minecraft Wednesday, November 8 at 3:45 PM

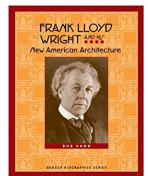
Book Discussion—Hillbilly Elegy Thursday, November 9 at 6:30 PM
