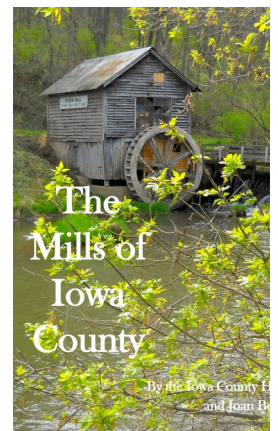


Harry Potter & the Chamber of Secrets
